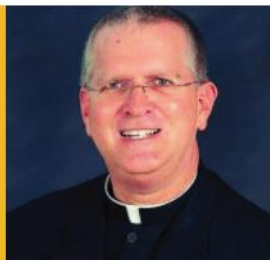

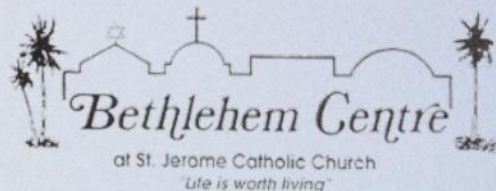

MAINTENANCE UPDATE

Since January, we have identified several maintenance items that have been deferred. Some of these have come from observations by our wonderful parishioners and others have been noted internally. This is a testament to our team effort as a parish to ensure that our campus is a place of spiritual enrichment and prioritizes ministry. Two key projects are highlighted below:

We are in the process of addressing our landscape beginning with fixing the sprinkler system so that it is up and running for our grounds to get watered. We have a 2-wire system with 22 zones. The electrical wiring and boxes required major repairs which will total nearly \$7,000 once the job is finished in 1-2 weeks. Once the system is up and running, our next step is to remove all drip lines, plug them, and replace any heads that need to be changed. Once the job is complete, we will have a company scheduled to do monthly or bi-monthly checking and maintenance to ensure that our intricate sprinkler system is well maintained.

A month ago, Father Tom shared that our plans to replace the red terrazzo in the church stalled. We are happy to share that Karcher Construction has been helping us obtain bids from new companies. We are in the process of looking over bids and discerning what company will do a quality job and meet our timeframe which is June to July. As it stands, this job will take 4-6 weeks requiring us to close the Church. During that time, we will be having Mass in the Parish Center. Once we secure a company and time, we will inform our parish community.

It has been encouraging to witness the generosity of our parishioners throughout this year. We want you to know how much we appreciate your generosity and sacrifice as we strive to be the hands and feet of Christ in our daily lives.

LIFELINE RECEIVES A++ ASSESSMENT

Last week, Lifeline served 116 families comprised of 439 people. 353 total families were served in April, comprised of 1,305 people. Parishioners donated 199 bags of food for a total of 937 bags for the month of April.

On Wednesday, a team from Feeding Tampa Bay visited Lifeline to conduct their annual site monitoring visit to insure that we are complying with required food safety standards and protocols for partner agency food pantries. Their summary report noted:

"I was so impressed, they are perfect. The St Jerome team is absolutely wonderful and treat the community with dignity and respect. They are very thoughtful about the types of food they prepare in client boxes. The storage building is very tidy and clean. Would love for other agencies to tour their pantry. No corrective action required. A++."

We are truly blessed to have such a dedicated team of volunteers and generous supportive parishioners.

The recent record numbers of people coming for assistance have seriously depleted our food supply. We are always in great need of the following:
